Condemnation, Redemption, Salvation, Justification, Sanctification, Glorification. Glorification: To make glorious by bestowing honor, praise, or admiration. To elevate to celestial glory.

1. The **TRANSFORMING** to Glorification

Phil 3:21 Who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself.

2 Cor 3:18 We all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.

NASU: We all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory

2. **SUFFERING** with Christ Here – **INHERITING** Glory with Christ There

Rom 8:17 If children, then heirs — heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together.

3. WORTHILY Living for Glorification

1 Thess 2:12 That you would walk worthy of God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory.

4. Genuine Faith **REWARDED** with Glorification

1 Peter 1:7 That the genuineness of your faith, being much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

5. Enthusiastically **AWAITING** the Glorification

1 Peter 5:1 The elders (pastor, spiritual guides) who are among you I exhort, I who am a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker of the glory that will be revealed.

AMP: As a fellow elder and as an eyewitness [called to testify] of the sufferings of Christ, as well as a sharer in the glory (the honor and splendor) that is to be revealed (disclosed, unfolded).

6. The **CROWNING** of Glorification

1 Peter 5:4 When the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that does not fade away.
