#### WHY IS ONE LOST?

- A. Original Sin (Adam).
  - 1. Rom. 5:12, 19.
  - 2. Gen. 1-3.
    - a. They were not created sinful.
    - b. Full fellowship with God, walked with Him in garden.
    - c. Became lost due to sin of unbelief.
      - 1) Believed Satan's lies.
      - 2) Believed in God, but did not believe God's word.
      - 3) Deut. 1:32. "Yet in this thing ye did not believe the LORD your God."
    - d. Died spiritually, would later die physically.
    - e. Lost close fellowship with God, though they evidently repented. Still suffered physical results.
      - 1) God still spoke to them, as Cain and Abel brought sacrifices.
- B. One's Own Sin.
  - 1. Rom. 3:10. "There is none righteous, no not one."
  - 2. Rom. 3:23. "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God."
  - 3. Romans 3 explains this.
- C. What About the "Innocent"?
  - 1. Luke 18:16-17.
  - 2. Deut. 1:39.

  - 1. Rom. 3:20, 28.
- B. By Grace of God.
  - 1. "grace" = charis (unmerited divine favor, gift).
  - 2. Eph. 2:4-10.
  - 3. How can God be "just" and still forgive our sins (justify us) by His grace?
    - a. Rom. 3:23-26.
      - 1) "Propitiation" (atonement, substitute)
    - b. 1 John 2:2.
    - c. 1 John 4:10.
    - d. Rom. 5:8,9.
  - 4. Rom. 1:16,17. "I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ...."

#### **HOW LONG DOES SALVATION LAST?**

- C. Acts 11:13-14. Peter's account of this event to church leaders in Jerusalem.
  - 1. Verse 14 "Who shall tell thee words, whereby thou and all thy house shall be saved."
