The Blood of the Redeemer

<u>Rev. 5:9</u>

Redeemer: One who frees or delivers another from difficulty, danger, or bondage, usually by the payment of a ransom price.

1. The Blood of <u>REDEMPTION</u>

Eph 1:7 In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace.

2. The Blood of <u>REMISSION</u>

Matt 26:28 For this is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

3. The Blood of <u>JUSTIFICATION</u>

Rom 5:9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.

4. The Blood of <u>RECONCILIATION</u>

Col 1:20 By Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross.

5. The Blood of <u>SANCTIFICATION</u>

Heb 13:12 Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered outside the gate.

6. The Blood of <u>ADMISSION</u>

Heb 10:19 Brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus.
