

1. The Lord's FAVOR

Zeph 3:17 The Lord your God.

Favor: An act of gracious kindness. A token of love.

- a) The Lord favorably undertakes. The Lord your God has undertaken for you. He is your God.

Ps 85:1 Lord, You have been favorable to Your land; You have brought back the captivity of Jacob. 2 You have forgiven the iniquity of Your people; You have covered all their sin.

2. The Lord's PRESENCE

Zeph 3:17 The Lord your God *in your midst*.

Deut 20:1 When you go out to battle against your enemies, and see horses and chariots and people more numerous than you, do not be afraid of them; for the Lord your God is with you, who brought you up from the land of Egypt.

God's presence is a reality in our lives; anywhere we go and whatever we do, the Lord is with us.

3. The Lord's POWER

Zeph 3:17 The Lord your God ... *The Mighty One*.

Mighty: Possessing might. Not given or attributed to Him by someone or something else.

- a) God is almighty.

Gen 17:1 When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the Lord appeared to Abram and said to him, "I am Almighty God."

Almighty: Having absolute power over all. unlimited in power

4. The Lord's SALVATION

Zeph 3:17 The Lord your God in your midst the Mighty One *will save*.

1 Tim 4:10 To this end we both labor and suffer reproach, because we trust in the living God, who is the Savior of all men, especially of those who believe.

5. The Lord's DELIGHT

Zeph 3:17 The Lord your God in your midst ... *He will rejoice over you with gladness*, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing.

- AMP In His love He will be silent and make no mention [of past sins, or even recall them].
- TLB He will love you and not accuse you.
