You were made to resemble God in two ways:

1. You resemble him by **nature**—it is inherent, part of being a human.

What does this mean in your life?

- You were created to be an image-bearer. You are unique among God's creation. Of all creation, only man is said to be made in the image of God—Genesis 1:26-27.
- You were not made for Hell. God does not need or desire His image in Hell—Matthew 25:41.

2. You resemble him by **behavior**—it is expected, part of being a Christian.
